

LETTER OF DECEMBER 3RD, 1998 TO THE PASTORS GROUP IN OSLO

December 03, 1998

Hi, brothers and friends!

I thank you for the communication from Gjermund with the statement that I should not continue in the group. That's honest, even though I believe it is a wrong decision. Naturally it pains me. But God will turn this around for good. I have much to learn, and hope and believe that the Lord will continue to teach me.

I don't think it is right to put a lot of effort into building a trusting relationship with you now, in that you have all expressed clearly a lack of trust in me. Perhaps both you and I will view things in a more nuanced way after some time. I don't carry grudges against you.

But I assume and hope that we will meet to cooperate in various settings where we will perform the Lord's work together.

Your and my responsibility is to accomplish the Lord's calling. For my part it's primarily to build the SeiersKirken church to be sound, strong and whole, and some other tasks that relate to the cell church. But it will also at times lead to acts and communications that will be perceived as strong – some will be happy, others not so happy. It is my responsibility to try to steward the gifts God has given me with integrity and credibility.

I wish God's abundant blessing and grace over each one of you!
